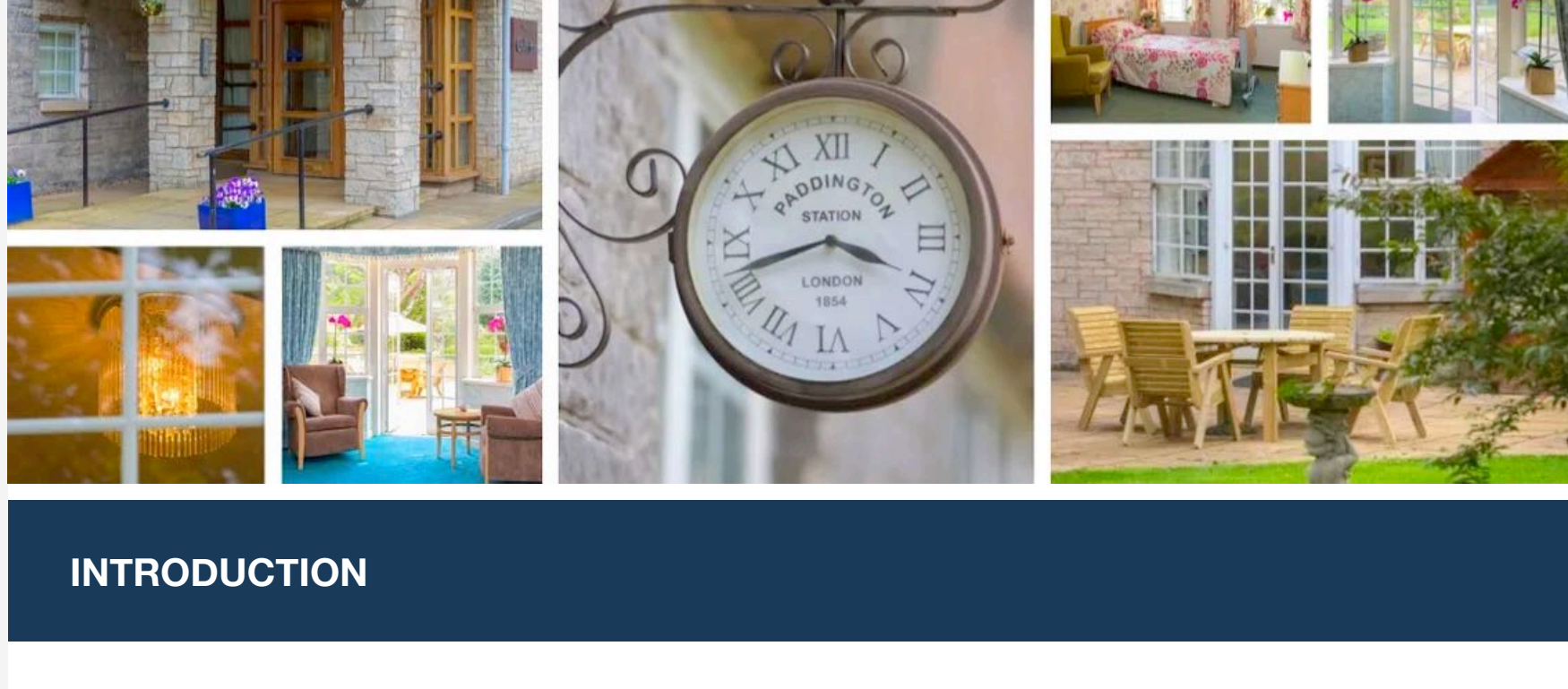




INTRODUCTION

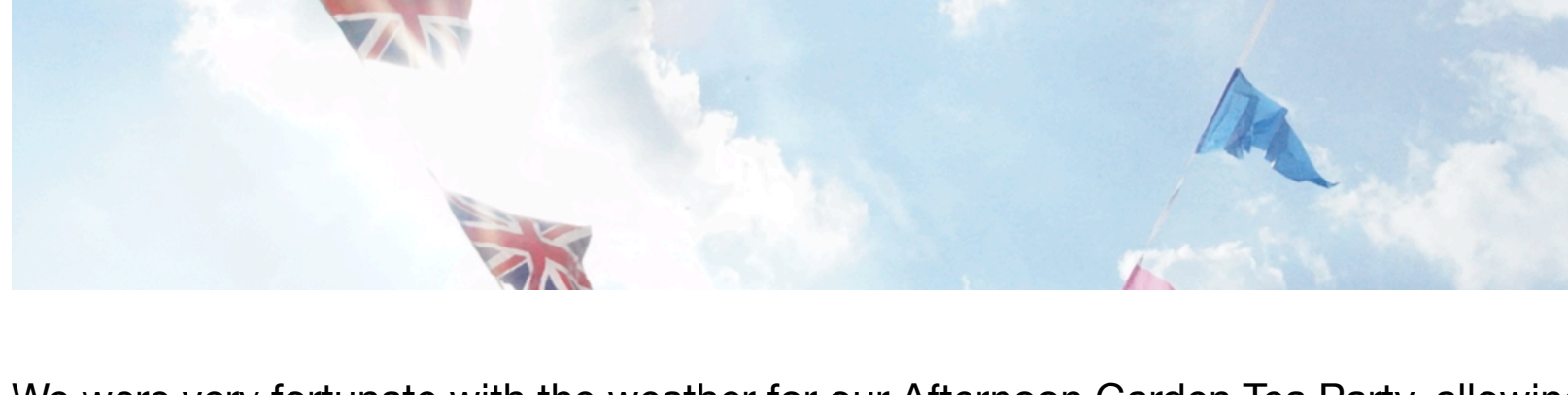

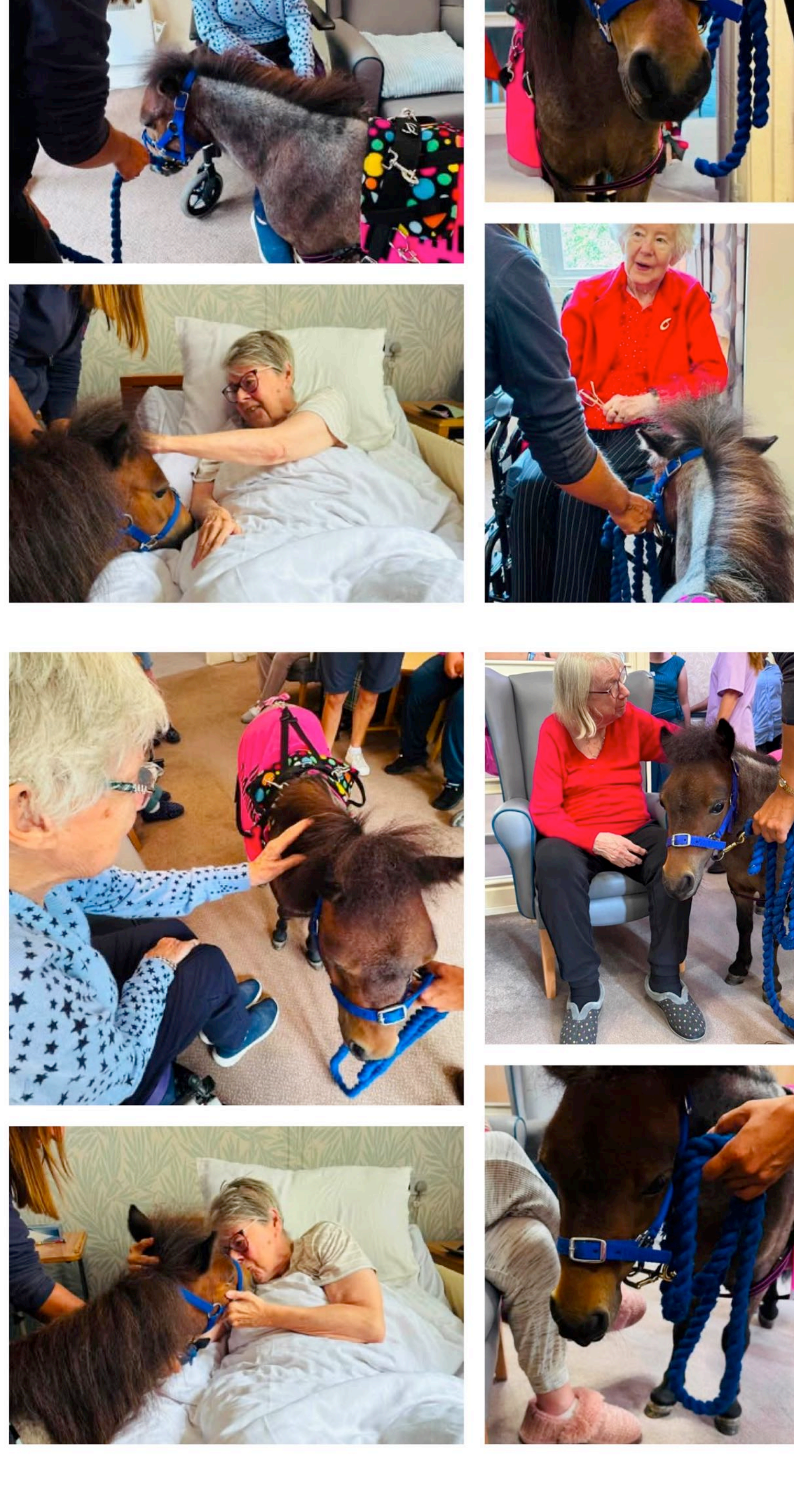
A Special Visit from Pip the Pony

Pip certainly made an impression, and we hope it will not be too long before we see him again.



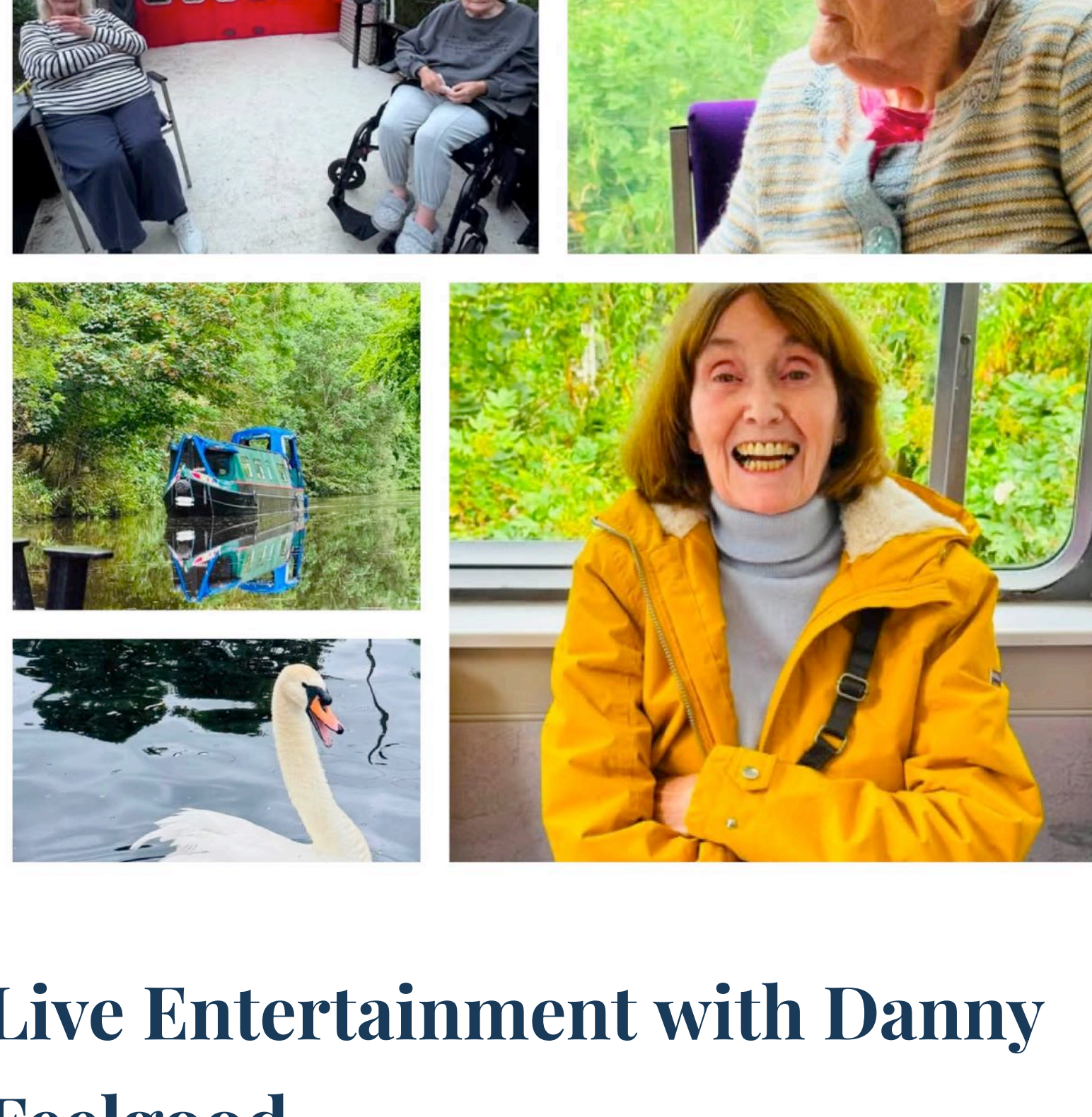
Our Final Barge Trip of the Season

We will be back on board in December for our Santa Cruise, which should be a lovely way to begin our Christmas celebrations.



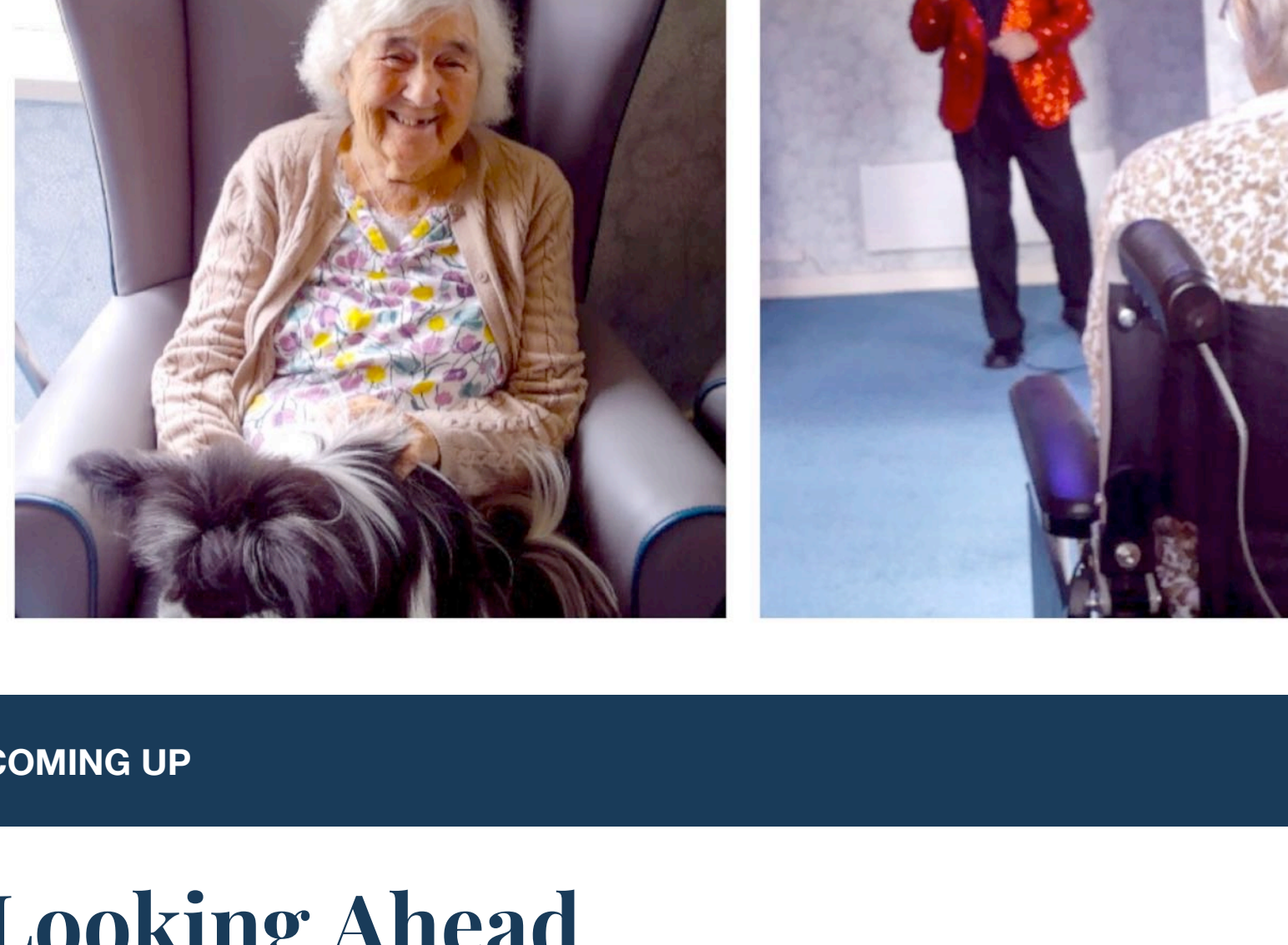
Live Entertainment with Danny Feelgood

Danny entertained everyone with a lively mixture of singing and dancing, and it was not long before residents were joining in with some of the familiar songs.

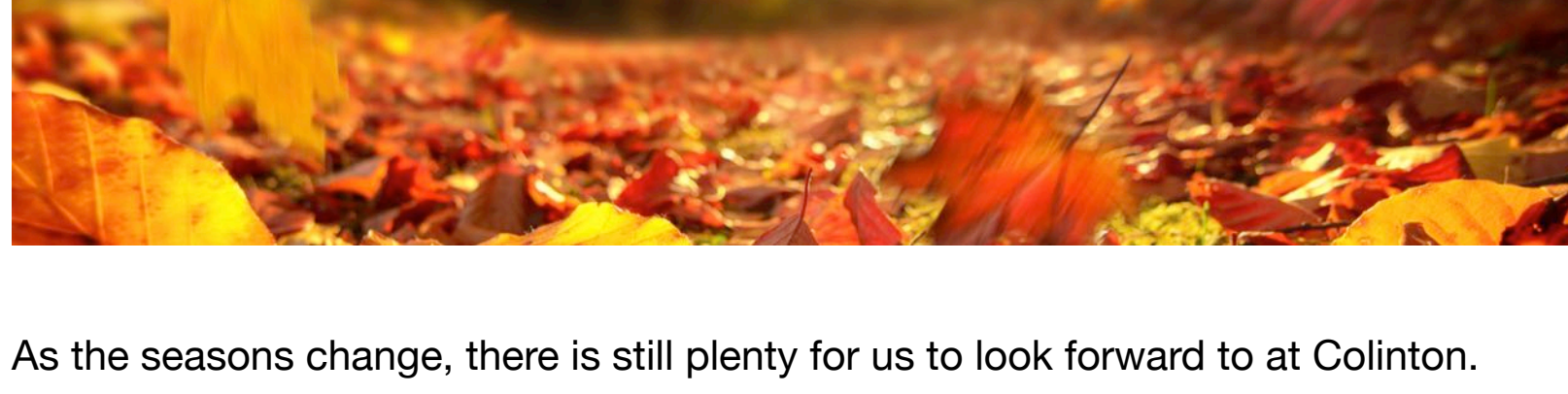
